6. Decision Noted on Application for: BA/2014/ 54B Yarmouth Road

Hand Car wash, car sales to be run as well as garden centre.

Strong objections to this application on following grounds.

Site is within the Thorpe St Andrew conservation area and this is contrary to the Conservation area policy, in that developments should enhance the street scene and view both looking into the area and within the area. This certainly does nothing to enhance the conservation area either looking into the area or within it. The proposed signage and screening will impact upon the green space to the east and north of the site and on the bungalow to the north which currently overlooks the site being in an elevated position to the site..

The proposed number of vehicle movements (60-70 customers per week) although not to severe at present will need to increase, for the business to be viable and this will have a major impact on the safety of traffic upon the road which is a main access route to the city. Similar establishments are washing around 40 cars per day. Turning right out of the site will impact upon the traffic flow especially at peak travel times.

The machinery, pressure washer, and general noise associated with the business is seen as not neighbourly and will affect the two properties to the west,

The business does not need to be in such a visibly sensitive location, as The Broads Authority development plan identifies Griffin Lane in Thorpe St Andrew, (1 mile away) as an industrial area and this is where a business of this type should be situated.

We would like to comment further that the application has taken months to be submitted and in that time the applicant that had scant regard for protocol or awareness of the neighbourhood erecting a plethora of signs balloons, and fly posters around the area, so we are very sceptical of any of the statements made regarding what is proposed. We therefore suggest that to grant permission certain conditions of use would be very necessary that would subsequently involve the BA in regular enforcement activity.
