Welcome to the 2022 Thorpe Poppy Project Trail and Quiz! In November 2021 the Royal British Legion celebrated their 250th Anniversary. The Thorpe Poppy Trails were based on a book called "Thorpe St. Andrew 1939-45 The War Memorial" written by local authors, John Balls and Dale Wiseman. It tells the histories of those who sadly lost their lives in WW2 who are named on the war memorial on Rivergreen. The trails featured Biography Poppy boards with a QR Code on them. The QR codes link to the Thorpe St. Andrew Town Councils Website. Using your camera on your smart phone position your open camera app over the QR Code to reveal a web link. By doing so you will access more information about the Servicemen that served in WW2 and their families who lived or have close links with Thorpe St Andrew.
