

Norfolk County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (the "Order") (NTRO9495) affecting the Yarmouth Road from 45m east of its junction with Griffin Lane for 90m eastwards (the "Road") in the Town of Thorpe St Andrew to facilitate Anglian Water manhole repair works, the Road will be temporarily closed (except for pedestrian access) for the duration of the works/period the closure is necessary which is anticipated to be between 19:00 and 06:00 from 28<sup>th</sup> to 29<sup>th</sup> April 2025, but may continue to be closed/restricted until the 10<sup>th</sup> June 2025 where the closure is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

Alternative route is via: A1042 Yarmouth Road, A1194(Broadland Way, Poppy Way), A1270 Broadland Northway, A1151 Wroxham Road, A1042 (Mousehold Lane, Heartsease Lane, St Williams Way, Ring Road, Yarmouth Road) (Rackheath, Sprowston, Thorpe St. Andrew, Postwick with Witton, Great and Little Plumstead).

The works promoter for this restriction/closure is: Anglian Water.

Vehicular access will be permitted to a final destination in the Road where signs indicating such access is possible and permitted are in place.

The Order shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works when the closure is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 10<sup>th</sup> June 2025 without further notice.

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date the Order is effective.

A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.
