Norfolk County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (the "Order") (NTRO9755a) affecting the A1242 Yarmouth Road from its junction with A1042 Ring Road for 210m westwards (the "Road") in the Town of Thorpe St. Andrew to facilitate BSIP carriageway improvement works. The Order continues the provisions of the Notice dated 1st June 2025 that traffic over the Road will be temporarily subject to a one-way restriction (eastbound only) allowing traffic to only travel westbound for the duration of the works/period the restriction is necessary which is anticipated to be from 7th June to 19th July 2025 (previously 2nd to 6th June 2025), but may continue to be restricted until the 19th January 2026 where the restriction is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

Alternative route is via: Northbound: Yarmouth Road, Thorpe Road, Carrow Road, A147 Carrow Road, Koblenz Avenue, King Street A1054 Bracondale/ Martineau Lane, A146 Loddon Road, A47, A1270 Broadland Northway, A1042 Yarmouth Road. Soundbound: A1042 Ring Road, Saint Williams Way, St Williams Way, B1140 Plumstead Road, Ketts Hill, A147 Bishop Bridge Road, Riverside Road, Riverside, Koblenz Avenue, Canary Way, Carrow Road, A1242 (Clarence Road, Thorpe Road, Yarmouth Road) (Thorpe St. Andrew CP (DET), Norwich City, Postwick).

The works promoter for this restriction is: Norfolk County Council.

Vehicular access will be permitted to a final destination in the Road where signs indicating such access is possible and permitted are in place.

The Order shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works when the restriction is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 19th January 2026 without further notice.

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date the first Notice was effective.

A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the restriction imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.


Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
